

Webinar: Update on the FTC's Rule to Ban Employee Non-Competes Nationwide

On April 23, 2024, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) adopted a rule banning employers from using non-competes with nearly all employees in the United States. This sweeping, nationwide regulation extends to other types of agreements such as non-solicitation and confidentiality agreements, as well as other restrictive covenants that could arguably prevent competition. Unless enjoined in pending litigation, the FTC's rule will take effect on September 4, 2024.
