In the [announcement of the transaction](#), Fellow Health CEO Brian Hogan said, "Male reproductive health shouldn't be reactive or inaccessible. We are on track to deliver over 40% year-over-year revenue growth, with a path to profitability in our fertility segment by 2026. This investment allows us to scale that vision and support both patients and providers with modern tools that work."
