In the [announcement of the transaction](#), founder of MilkRun Julia Niiro said, “Our model is to increase profits by helping small farmers get more of their goods purchased. Like the traditional milkman model, people buy directly from the farm and have it delivered. This next wave of the food industry will be how to reduce the middle.”
