The Gunderson deal team was led by Zach Crowe and included Caitlin Walsh.

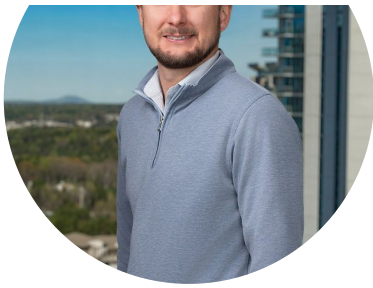
