In the announcement of the transaction Dina Chaya, Advisor to Omega Funds, said "We are impressed with the potential for tildacerfont to become the first approved treatment for patients with classic congenital adrenal hyperplasia around the world, as well as the encouraging positive results recently announced from its Phase 2 clinical trial. This drug could be a life-altering therapy for patients with CAH."
